How the course can fit your style

- **Synchronous** Follow the live schedule (best for discipline, peer support, live doubt clearing).
- **Asynchronous** Use the complete previous-cycle course at your own pace (best for time-flexible learners or those who miss live timings).
 - We **recommend a guided path** (book your free 1:1) so a mentor can create a hybrid plan tailored to your priorities and constraints.

Week-1 plan (General Studies foundation)

We begin with **4 core papers** that form the foundation of civil services preparation. Week-1 is structured to build that foundation quickly:

- Day 1–2: Polity Core concepts, NCERT / standard note summaries, key cases.
- Day 3-4: Economy Basic macro concepts, budgeting, recent economic developments.
- Day 5–6: History Modern India focus + theme-wise events for prelims/mains.
- Day 7: Geography Physical geography basics + relevant maps & diagrams.

All **notes and lecture links** are in the Week-1 folder. If your mentor sets a *custom path*, you will also see the additional content assigned to you.

Practical study actions

These are short, actionable habits to follow during your demo and beyond:

- **Regularity:** We humans are creatures of habit. Habit is easy to form. Try to schedule your class at the same time every day.
- 'Before Class-After Class' Revision Routine: Revision is the key to mastering any skill. We recommend attending a class only after revision of past classes and doing a class revision the same day before sleep. This method as proven to be highly effective in long-term concept recall.
- Active recall: After each class, write 5 short questions and answer them without notes.
- **Spaced repetition:** Revisit notes after 24 hrs, 7 days, and 30 days.
- **Timed practice:** Do at least one 30–60 minute prelims style quiz in the week.
- Mains habit: Convert one class topic into a 250–300 word answer twice this week (self-evaluate using the model answer).

Assessments & feedback

- Weekly 1:1 Review (Free): short progress check, doubt clearing, target adjustment.
- Monthly Assessment & Feedback: timed test + detailed feedback to evaluate readiness and update your path.

What to bring to a review: your specific doubt questions, recent self-tests, one mains answer you wrote.
